

## General Information

The map on the other side of this handout shows the local area and a number of facilities where you may buy snacks, coffee or a warm meal. If you intend to take your meal at the Mensa (= dining hall), you will have to lease a mensa-card first. This can be done at the Infocenter in the same building.

• Connecting to the University of Heidelberg's conference network (WLAN)

Activate your network card and set it to **"obtain IP-address automatically"** (DHCP). Our network ID (SSID) is **"UNI-HEIDELBERG"**.
