







Workshop 'Iwasawa Theory and Related Topics",

Heidelberg, May 14-18, 2018

Practical Information

Workshop Venue

The conference will take place on the campus of the Ruprecht-Karls-Universität Heidelberg in the north-west of Heidelberg. All street addresses of the campus are indicated as "Im Neuenheimer Feld", INF for short, and usually building INF xyz has the number xyz written on it.

Registration, plenary talks and the conference office are in the Mathematikon, INF 205, 5th floor. To reach the Mathematikon by bus or tram, you need to get off at the stop "Bunsengymnasium". Directly across the stop "Bunsengymnasium" and across Shell gas station you find the building "Mathematikon" (intersection Berliner Str./Mönchhofstr.). The place in front of the Mathematikon is called "Klaus-Tschira-Platz".

Registration

The registration desk is located in the 5th floor of the Mathematikon, INF 205, the building where the talks will take place. Here registered participants will collect their conference materials and name tags. Please note that all payments (for example mensa vouchers or Conference Dinner) have to be made in cash (in Euro). If you have any problems or need help, you may always ask the members of the organizing committee or contact us at the registration desk during the following opening hours:

Monday: 8.00 am - 9.30 am and every morning during the coffee breaks.

Internet Access Mathematical Institute

There are the following options to get access to the Internet:

Access with your own device:

1. EDUROAM (education roaming): The University of Heidelberg is a participant of the eduroam service. In order to use it, your university/institution has to participate in the program. Moreover, you need to have an account from your university/institution, which you may use to connect to the network "eduroam" on the campus.

2. If EDUROAM does not work: At the workshop/registration desk you can get a temporary account. We suggest connecting to UNI-WEBACCESS first and follow the instructions https://cat.eduroam.de/ to permanently connect to EDUROAM for the duration of the conference if you want.

Eating around the Campus

Zentralmensa Neuenheimer Feld (Student Canteen)

11.30 am - 2.00 pm (Mon - Fri)

In order to have lunch at the mensa/canteen you need to obtain mensa vouchers from the workshop/registration desk. Each voucher can be used on every day and is transferrable. Each mensa voucher is valid for one meal from the free-flow-buffet (soup or dessert are not included). Regular price is 7 Euro, 5 Euro for students. Workshop participants will be served at counter A. To get there, after entering the building from the main (north) entrance, follow the ramp in front of you and then take the staircase just ahead of you.

Alternatively you can try any of the following option, but please keep in mind that the mensa vouchers are not valid. Please note that many restaurants and shops in Germany only accept cash.

Café Botanik (Student Cafeteria)

8 am - 12 pm (Mon - Thu) 8 am - 10 pm (Fri)

This is a self-service restaurant and beer garden in the same building as the Zentralmensa. Eating here is a good option if you are looking for reasonably priced quick food. Afterwards you may want to take a stroll through the botanical garden right behind the café.

Café Bellini

Dinner will start around 7 pm (additional payment for participants 20 Euro, please choose the menu at registration desk and pay there). The restaurant is close to the Theaterplatz and Universitätsplatz (theatre square or university square, bus lines 30, 31 and 32 to Universitätsplatz).

How to reach the Campus

The stop "Bunsengymnasium" can be reached by public transport

- from Heidelberg main station by Tram 21 or 24,
- from Bismarckplatz by Bus 31 or Tram 22 to Betriebshof and Tram 21 or 24 from Betriebshof to Bunsengymnasium,
- from University Square in Old Town by Bus 31.

Make sure to go in the right direction,

- for Tram 21 or 24 go in direction "Handschuhsheim"
- for Bus 31 go in direction "Neuenheim Chirurgische Klinik" (for more information see: http://www.vrn.de/)

Tickets for Buses and Trams

Tickets can be bought

- at a counter in the main station
- from automatic machines in the main station or at stations
- at the "RNV-Kunden-Centrum" across the main station,
 open: Mon Fri: 10 am 18 pm, Sat: 10 am 15 pm
- from bus drivers

Note that there are no tickets sold in trams, i.e., you have to get them in advance. Depending on where you buy them, they may come with a time stamp, if not, the ticket must be validated after getting on the bus or tram.

There is a unified public transportation system for a wide area around Heidelberg. The following prices are for rides within Heidelberg centre and adjacent suburbs. A single ticket is $2.60 \in$, a daily ticket is $6.70 \in$, 3 day ticket is $16.20 \in$ and a weekly ticket can be bought for $23.70 \in$ (valid from Monday till Monday).

You can also easily rent bikes in Heidelberg via VRN nextbike (http://www.vrnnextbike.de/en/): After registration on that website, you can rent bikes from nextbike stations that are located all over Heidelberg for 1€/30min. The station closest to the conference venue is at the north-west end of the Mathematikon buildings just north of the intersection.
