## Practical Information

### Conference Venue

The conference will take place on the campus of the Ruprecht-Karls-Universität Heidelberg in the north-west of Heidelberg. All street addresses of the campus are indicated as “Im Neuenheimer Feld”, INF for short, and usually building INF xyz has the number xyz written on it.

Registration, plenary talks and the conference office are in the Mathematical Institute INF 288. To reach the Math. Institute by bus or tram, you need to get off at the stop “Bunsengymnasium”. Then walk perpendicular to the tram tracks and towards the campus, passing parking lots on both sides and then the left only. About 200 meters away from the tram stop, you reach the large central square of the campus with a pavement that shows the solar system as concentric circles. A few meters off the square to your right you see the Mathematical Institute INF 288.

### Registration

The registration desks are located in the lobby of the Mathematical Institute INF 288, the building where the talks will take place. Here registered participants will collect their conference materials and name tags. Please note that all payments (for example Mensa vouchers or Conference Dinner) have to be made in cash (in Euro). ## Internet Access Mathematical Institute

There are the following options to get access to the Internet:

### 1. Access with your own laptop:

#### a) WLAN via “UNI-WEBACCESS”:

First, connect to the wireless network “UNI-WEBACCESS”, which does not require a password. Then, go to your favourite website. You will be redirected to the wireless captive portal login page. Here you enter the username and the password that will be provided on arrival at the Mathematical Institute.

#### b) EDUROAM (education roaming):

The University of Heidelberg is a participant of the eduroam service. In order to use it your university/institution has to participate in the program. Moreover, you need to have an account from your university/institution, which you may use to connect to the network “eduroam” on the campus.

### 2. Access via Computing Lab:

A small computing lab with access to the Internet will be open for conference participants. It will be open each day from 8:30 am until one hour after the end of the day's last lecture.

It is located in room 011 in the basement of the Mathematical Institute, building INF 288. After entering the building just go down the staircase halfway on your left and follow the information signs to get there.

## Eating around the Campus

### *Zentralmensa Neuenheimer Feld (Student Canteen)*

*Opening hours: 11.30 am - 2.00 pm (Mon - Fri)*

In order to have lunch at the mensa/canteen you need to obtain mensa-vouchers from the conference desk. Each voucher can be used on every day and is transferrable. Each mensa voucher is valid for one meal from the free-flow-buffet (soup, dessert are not included but you could pay for them with cash). Regular price is 7 Euro, 5 Euro for students. Iwasawa participants will be served at counter A. To get there, after entering the building from the main (north) entrance, follow the ramp in front of you and then take the staircase just ahead of you.

### *Café Botanik (Student Cafeteria)*

*8 am - 12 pm (Mon - Thu)*

*8 am – 10 pm (Fri)*

This is a self-service restaurant and beer garden in the same building as the Zentralmensa. Eating here is a good option if you are looking for reasonably priced quick food. Afterwards you may want to take a stroll through the botanical garden right behind the café.

*Casino DKFZ*

*11 am - 4.30 pm, lunch 11 am - 2.30 pm*

The self-service cafeteria “Casino” of the German Cancer Research Center (DKFZ) is directly opposite to the Bellini. Just enter through the revolving door and in the lobby turn left to get to the cafeteria. Only the cashier on the right accepts cash. There is no food offered after 2.30 pm, but it is still possible to have a coffee here.

- from “Bismarckplatz” by Bus 31 or Tram 22 to “Betriebshof” and Tram 21 or 24 from “Betriebshof” to “Bunsengymnasium”,
- from University Square in Old Town by Bus 31.

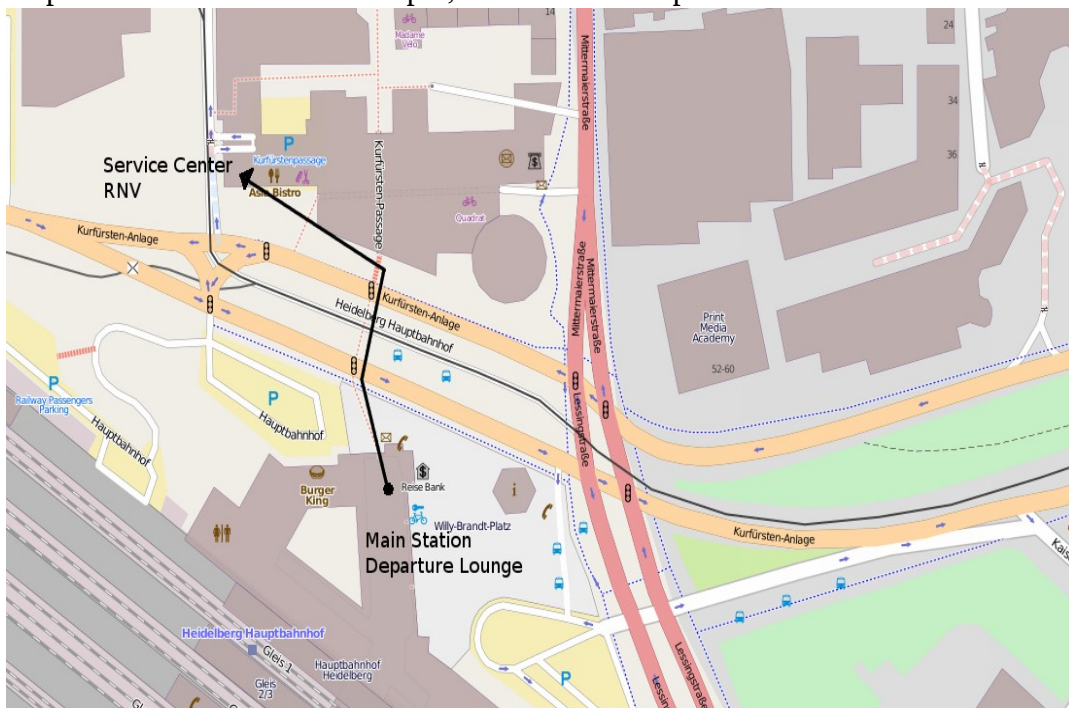
Make sure to go in the right direction,

- for Tram 21 or 24 go in direction “Handschuhshheim”
- for Bus 31 go in direction “Neuenheim Chirurgische Klinik”

## Tickets for Buses and Trams

Tickets can be bought

- at a counter in the main station
  - from automatic machines in the main station or at stations
  - at the “RNV-Kunden-Centrum” across the main station (see map)
- open: Mon – Fri: 10 am – 18 pm, Sat: 10 am – 15 pm



- from bus drivers.

Note that there are no tickets sold in trams, i.e., you have to get them in advance. Depending on where you buy them, they may come with a time stamp, if not, the ticket must be validated after getting on the bus or tram.

There is a unified public transportation system for a wide area around Heidelberg. The following prices are for rides within Heidelberg centre and adjacent suburbs. A *single ticket* is 2.30 €, *3 day ticket* is 13,70 € and a *weekly ticket* can be bought for 20 € (valid from Monday till Monday).

There is a *24-hour ticket* available (which is valid till Monday 3 a.m. when bought on the weekend). The price is 5.50 € for one person (Ticket 24) and 9.60 Euro for a group of up to 5 (Ticket 24 Plus). No liability taken!
